INCREASED LEAD SCREENING REQUIREMENTS

Ensured all pregnant mothers are screened for lead exposure and strengthened lead screening requirements for children under 2.



PROTECTED SNAP BENEFITS

In the face of proposed cuts 50,000 children maintained food assistance including free and reduced cost school lunch.



PASSED LEGISLATION TO KEEP KIDS OUT OF ADULT COURT SYSTEM

More than 7,000 youth who make a mistake will now have a second chance.



HELD STRONG FOR KIDS' HEALTH

In response to proposed cuts to health insurance programs, 1.3 million kids (and tens of thousands of parents) kept their health insurance.



CHILD ADVOCACY NETWORK

Engaged over 7,000 North Carolinians to be a strong voice for policy solutions that build healthy children, families and communities.



ADVOCACY

Ensured the needs of our youngest generation were front and center at the legislature, in the Governor's office, and with federal, state, and local leaders.

Released data products to highlight important trends in child well-being and the impact of public policies on our kids.



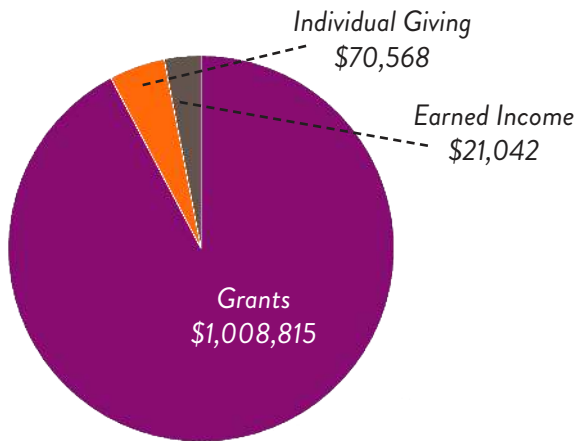

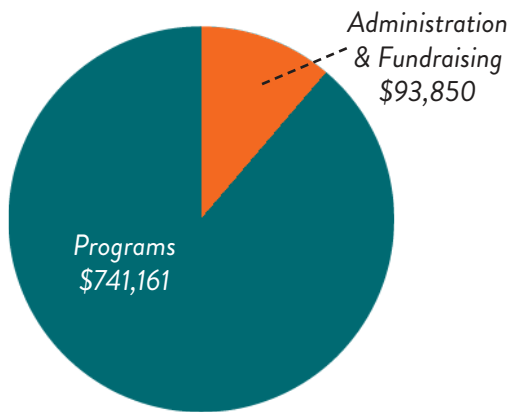
