



NEED HEALTH INSURANCE? YOU MAY QUALIFY FOR FREE OR LOW-COST COVERAGE THROUGH NC MEDICAID.

Beginning **December 1st**, more North Carolinians can get Medicaid health coverage. **Find out if you qualify and apply today.**

ARE YOU ELIGIBLE?

You may be eligible for coverage if you:

- Live in North Carolina
- Are between the ages of 19 64
- Are a U.S. resident
- Have an annual household income at or below the following limits:

HOUSEHOLD SIZE	ANNUAL INCOME
Single Adults	\$20,120 or less
Family of 2	\$27,214 or less
Family of 3	\$34,307 or less
Family of 4	\$41,400 or less
Family of 5	\$48,493 or less
Family of 6	\$55,586 or less

Even if you haven't qualified for Medicaid in the past—or if you recently lost coverage—you may now be eligible.

WHAT'S COVERED?

NC Medicaid covers:



Primary care



Vision and hearing services



Preventative services



Hospital services, both inpatient and outpatient



Prescription drug benefits



Dental services





Medical-related devices and other therapies

WHAT DO I NEED TO APPLY?

Full legal name, date of birth, Social Security number, North Carolina residency, and income information

READY TO APPLY?

- Online: ePass epass.nc.gov
- Mail: Print a paper application medicaid.nc.gov/print-application •
- In person: Visit your local Department of Social Services office ncdhhs.gov/localDSS •
- Phone: Call your local Department of Social Services office ncdhhs.gov/localDSS

WHEN DOES MEDICAID COVERAGE BEGIN?

- You will receive a letter in the mail up to 45 days after the submission of your application.
- If you apply in December, your application will not be processed until January, or later.
